**Addendum to the CSA Use of Information and Confidentiality Policy**

Investors are demonstrating a growing interest in evaluating companies’ ESG performance and depend on the associated data for a thorough assessment. The questions detailed in this Addendum represent the most commonly requested data point inquired by investors.

The CSA methodology does not require the data points provided in the CSA questions below to be publicly available. However, S&P Global reserves the right to publish and redistribute data points from the below CSA questions below at its discretion solely via its paid professional platforms, irrespective of the data point confidentiality selection chosen by a company. Such data points may be updated by S&P Global for each CSA cycle.
