# S&P Global Sustainability Yearbook Emblem Guidelines

The following Guidelines apply to use of the S&P Global Sustainability Yearbook Emblem and words, phrases, symbols, designs and other distinctive brand features associated therewith (the “Yearbook Emblem”). Improper use of the Yearbook Emblem weakens the quality of these logos and S&P Global may take all legal or other actions necessary to protect the Yearbook Emblem. In these Guidelines, “you” means any user of the Yearbook Emblem.

By accessing and using the Yearbook Emblem, you agree to these Guidelines. If you are reviewing these Guidelines in order to use the Yearbook Emblem on behalf of an organization, you represent that you have authority to agree to these Guidelines on behalf of such organization.

1. You shall reproduce the Yearbook Emblem in the form provided by S&P global. You shall not alter or modify the Yearbook Emblem artwork, including color specifications, clear space, position, cropping, or resizing the original proportion, as provided to you by S&P Global.
2. You shall maintain clear space between other emblems, symbols, signatures, or copy.
3. You shall not place the Yearbook Emblem on a textured or heavily patterned background.
4. The Yearbook Emblem may be used in your internal and external communications, but may not be used in conjunction with advertising for a specific product or service.
5. Your affiliates may not use the Yearbook Emblem unless the materials containing the Yearbook Emblem would be permitted hereunder if they were issued by you and expressly indicate the identity of the recognition.
6. You shall not use the Yearbook Emblem as part of a headline or other copy treatment.
7. You shall not use the Yearbook Emblem in a containment graphic.

You acknowledge and agree that S&P Global reserves the right to revoke permission to use a Yearbook Emblem if S&P Global determines, in its sole discretion, that your use of the Yearbook Emblem is in S&P Global’s reasonable judgment likely to disparage or impair the reputation and integrity of the Yearbook Emblem.
9. You acknowledge and agree that S&P Global reserves the right to adjust or revoke a company’s designation level in the Yearbook if a company’s S&P Global CSA Score changes based on corporate controversies as a result of the S&P Global Media and Stakeholder Analysis process.
